Creating eco-creative jewellery

This initiative seeks to create original and creative pieces based on the 'City of Camellias' theme. These works will be created using the high and low relief assemblage and collage technique, using reused materials, paper and natural elements.

Tea tasting

The tea plant (Camellia sinensis) can produce teas in almost any colour, from white to green, from yellow to red and black, which lead senses to different tasting experiences. This workshop will show you the secrets of tea cultivation and production, and will include the tasting of several samples.

Examples include species such as 'Hagomoro', 'Marmorata', 'Castilho, the Poet', among others. In this workshop, camellias of different colours will be made using cardboard in split slices and various threads.
